APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Crooked River
(Name of stream)

2. The appropriation to be made by the enlargement (or extension) of Horseshoe Bend and Nelson Ditch

owned by Myer, Brown and E. W. Nelson

3. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is one inch per acre cubic feet per second, which amount is in addition to the present claimed appropriation.

(d) The dimensions of said ditch just below the headgate are: Width on top (at water line) 8 feet; width on bottom 7 feet; depth of water 14 in. feet; grade 1/4 per R. feet fall per 1000 feet, having a maximum safe capacity of 7 cubic feet per second.

(e) Said ditch now serves to irrigate the following described land:

NE 1/4 and NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 16 T 17 R 22

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The appropriation for irrigation purposes shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cu. ft. per sec. for each acre irrigated.

The priority date of this permit is July 6, 1911

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 88/100 (0.88) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Aug 7 1912

and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
