

*Enlargement Permit No. 121

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

I, W O Benjamin (Name of Applicant)

of Placer (Postoffice), County of Josephine

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Short Creek which runs through Sect 8 Town. 34 R. 5 West in a southwesterly direction and existing ditch
2. The appropriation to be made by the enlargement (or extension) of existing ditch used by R S Blalock for irrigating uses on garden.

3. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is one 0.1 cubic feet per second, which amount is in addition to the present claimed appropriation.

4. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation and Domestic purposes (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

Location and Description of Ditch or Works which it is Proposed to Enlarge or Extend

5. (a) The point of diversion from the stream is 3300 feet south west from northeast corner of Sec. 8 (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

(b) The headgate is located within the SW 40 of NE 1/4 of (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. Eight, Tp. Thirty-Four S, R. Five West, W. M., in the county of Josephine (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

(c) Said Ditch is 315 feet miles in length and terminates in the SW 40 of NE 1/4 of Sec. Eight, Tp. Thirty-four, R. five West (Smallest legal subdivision)

(d) The dimensions of said ditch just below the headgate are: Width on top (at water line) 10 inches feet; width on bottom 6 inches feet; depth of water 3 inches feet; grade 1 1/2 inches feet fall per 1000 feet, having a maximum safe capacity of 36 cubic feet per second.

(e) Said ditch now serves to irrigate the following described land: 1/4 acre of vegetable garden (If not used for irrigation, give purpose for which said ditch is used, extent of power developed, mines served, etc.)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The appropriation for irrigation purposes shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cu. ft. per sec. for each acre irrigated, balance of appropriation for domestic use.

The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 30, 1911.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 1/10 (0.10) cubic feet per second. or its equivalent in case of rotation.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 6, 1912

and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

December 6, 1913

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

December 6, 1914
