*Enlargement Permit No. 147

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

47970

I, Dufur, Orchard Land Company (Incorporated)

of Dufur, County of Wasco, State of Oregon

do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation. Dufur, Oregon, December 20th, 1907

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Fifteen Mile Creek -

2. The appropriation to be made by the enlargement (or extension) of Meadow Brook Ditch

owned by Herbert S., and Carl F Galligan

3. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is two-thirds cubic feet per second, which amount is in addition to the present claimed appropriation.

4. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

Location and Description of Ditch or Works which it is Proposed to Enlarge or Extend—

5. (a) The point of diversion from the stream is South westerly from land described

(b) The headgate is located within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 1, Tp. 2 S, R. 12 E, Wasco

(c) Said ditch is 3/4 miles in length and terminates in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 6, Tp. 2 S, R. 13 E

W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

(d) The dimensions of said ditch just below the headgate are: Width on top (at water line) one foot, width on bottom ten inches, depth of water six inches, grade 3/8 in. per foot fall per 1000 feet, having a maximum safe capacity of 2/3 cubic feet per second.

(e) Said ditch now serves to irrigate the following described land: Meadow Brook Park, a plat of which is recorded in Plats Bk #1, pages 47 & 48, Wasco County, and is in the S 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Section 31 Tp 1 S R 13 E and N 1/2 of the NW 1/4 and the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 6 Tp. 2 S R 13 E.W.M.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The appropriation for irrigation purposes shall

be limited to one-eightieth of one cu. ft. per sec. for each acre irrigated. The use here- under shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State officers.

The priority date of this permit is August 3, 1912

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 3/8 (0.375) or its equivalent cubic feet per second. in case of rotation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 21, 1913

and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1914

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1915
