APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

THE PLEASANTVIEW IRRIGATION CO. INC.

I, (Name of Applicant)

of Milton, County of Umatilla (Postoffice)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation April 22, 1912 Milton, Oreg.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Little Walla Walla Branch of the Walla Walla River (Name of stream)

2. The appropriation to be made by the enlargement (or extension) of The Pleasantview Irrigation Co. Ditch (Give name or canal or works to be enlarged)

owned by Pleasantview Irrigation Co., Inc.

3. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .875 cubic feet per second, which amount is in addition to the present claimed appropriation.

4. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

(b) The headgate is located within the S 1/2 of N 1/2 of NE 1/4 (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. 2, Tp. 5 N, R. 35 E, W. M., in the county of Umatilla (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

(c) Said ditch is 5 miles in length and terminates in the NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 29, Tp. 6 N, R. 35 E (Smallest legal subdivision)

W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

(d) The dimensions of said ditch just below the headgate are: Width on top (at water line) feet; width on bottom feet; depth of water feet; grade feet fall per 1000 feet, having a maximum safe capacity of cubic feet per second.

(e) Said ditch now serves to irrigate the following described land: Given on previous filing Water users of the Powell Ditch as shown in the Court's decree (If not used for irrigation, give purpose for which said ditch is used, extent of power developed, mines served, etc.) in settling water rights on the Little Walla Walla River.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The appropriation for irrigation purposes shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cu. ft. per sec. for each acre irrigated. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable system of rotation ordered by the proper State officers. The priority date of this permit is June 30th, 1913.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 7/8 or its equivalent in cubic feet per second. case of rotation.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Sep 1st, 1914 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1st, 1915

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct 1st, 1916
