

\*Enlargement Permit No. APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

I, Hermiston Light & Power Co. (Name of Applicant)

of Hermiston, County of Umatilla (Postoffice)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

Articles of incorporation filed with the State 31st day of May, 1911

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Umatilla River (Name of stream)

2. The appropriation to be made by the enlargement (or extension) of Ditch of the Hermiston Light & Power Co. formerly called Hurlbert Power Ditch (Give name or canal or works to be enlarged)

owned by Hermiston Light & Power Co.

3. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 29.3 cubic feet per second, which amount is in addition to the present claimed appropriation.

4. The use to which the water is to be applied is Power (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

Location and Description of Ditch or Works which it is Proposed to Enlarge or Extend

5. (a) The point of diversion from the stream is 1798-3 ft. N 66° 04" E from SW cor. Sec. 16 T 4 N R 28 E.W.M. (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

(b) The headgate is located within the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. 16, Tp. 4 N, R. 28 E, W. M., in the county of Umatilla

(c) Said ditch is 4860 feet miles in length and terminates in the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 4 N, R. 28 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

(d) The dimensions of said ditch just below the headgate are: Width on top (at water line) 13 feet; width on bottom 9 feet; depth of water 1.3 feet; grade 3/10 feet fall per 100 feet, having a maximum safe capacity of cubic feet per second.

(e) Said ditch now serves to irrigate the following described land: Used to furnish water power for the Hermiston Light & Power Co., which is selling electric current in the town of Hermiston, Oregon. The amount of power now developed is approximately 50 horse power. (If not used for irrigation, give purpose for which said ditch is used, extent of power developed, mines served, etc.)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This appropriation shall be limited to the development of 71 theoretical horsepower.

The priority date of this permit is August 7th, 1913

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed Twenty-Nine & 3/10 (29.3) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Jan 5th, 1915

and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1st, 1916

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

Oct. 1st, 1917
