APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

I, We, Albert Brokaw, Wilhelm Olsen Mikvold, and Amable Gravel  
(Name of Applicant)  
of Copperfield, County of Baker  
(Postoffice)  
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.....

- The source of the proposed appropriation is Pine Creek  
(Name of stream)
- The appropriation to be made by the enlargement ~~and~~ extension) of what is known as  
the Bassette and Reckling Ditch  
(Give name or canal or works to be enlarged)  
owned by E E Disbrow and Stanley R. Dinnick
- The amount of water which the applicants intend to apply to beneficial use is 2  
2 cubic feet per second, which amount is in addition to the present claimed appropriation.
- The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation  
(Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

Location and Description of Ditch or Works which it is Proposed to Enlarge or Extend—

- (a) The point of diversion from the stream is in SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 Sec 18 Tp 8 S R 47 E  
(Give distance and bearing to section corner)
- (b) The headgate is located within the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4  
(Smallest legal subdivision)  
of Sec. 18, Tp. 8 S, R. 47 E, W. M., in the county of Baker  
(No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)
- (c) Said ditch is 2.79 miles in length and terminates in the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4  
(Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. 8, Tp. 8 S, R. 47 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.
- (d) The dimensions of said ditch just below the headgate are: Width on top (at water line) 24 inches feet; width on bottom 30 inches feet; depth of water 1 2/3 feet; grade 1 1/2 feet fall per 1000 feet, having a maximum safe capacity of 1/4 to 1/2 cubic feet per second. at 1/4 mile below headgate
- (e) Said ditch now serves to irrigate the following described land: about 30 acres of land belonging to E. E. Disbrow, in the S 1/2 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 7 and in the N 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 18 Tp 8 S, R 47 E of W. M.  
(If not used for irrigation, give purpose for which said ditch is used, extent of power developed, mines served, etc.)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The appropriation for irrigation purposes shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cu. ft. per sec. for each acre irrigated.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed one & 25/100 (1.25) cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before Jan 23 1912

and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

Jan 23 1913 EXTENDED TO 7/1/13

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

Jan 23 1914 EXTENDED TO 7/1/14
