PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION $\,$ G-10820 $\,$ and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to USDA, Forest Service, Deschutes National Forest, 211 Northeast Revere, Bend, Oregon 97701, phone 382-6922 for use of the waters of one well

potable water supply for Crane Prairie Resort

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 30, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per

measured at the point of diversion from the well , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 3,060 feet North and 1,700 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 34, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 34, Township 20 South, Range 8 East, WM, in the County of Deschutes.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 20 South, Range 8 East, WM

Section 34 SE 1/4 NW 1/4

Use of water uinder this permit shall be limited to the appropriation of water only to the extent that such appropriation does not interfere with or deplete the flow of the Deschutes River. Any depletion will require the well to be shut down, since the Deschutes River has been closed to further appropriation.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 15, 1984 diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 84.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 85.
