PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10853 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to City of Haines, Oregon of PO Box 208, Haines, Oregon 97833, phone 856-3366 for use of the waters of Well 3

for the PURPOSE of

municipal

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 17, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 800 gallons per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the well , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 1,810 feet South and 950 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 33, (Lot 4, Block 8 of the Haines Revised Plat, Section 33), being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33, Township 7 South, Range 39 East, WM, in the County of Baker.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: Township 7 South, Range 39 East, WM Section 33 NE 1/4

E 1/2 NW 1/4

E1/2 SW 1/4

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 15, 1984 diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984

, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985
