PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10466 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Avion Water Co., Inc., 60813 Parrell Road, Bend, Oregon 97702, phone 382-5342 for use of the waters of three wells; being 0.13 cubic foot per second from Well 1; 0.15 cfs from Well 2 and 0.35 cfs from Well 3, (Chaparral)

for the PURPOSE of group domestic supply for 203 families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden for each

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 24, 1981

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.63 cfs

measured at the point of diversion from the wells , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 1,230 feet North and 948 feet East from the \$1/4\$ of Section 36, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4; Well 2 - 2,100 feet North and 110 feet West from the \$1/4 Corner of Section 36, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4; Well 3 - 2,070 feet North and 130 feet West from the \$1/4 Corner of Section 36, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, all within Section 36,* A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* Township 15 South, Range 12 East, WM, in the County of Deschutes.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984

Extended to October 1, 1989, extended to Octobe

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985
