PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10649 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Arie Mack Moore and Evanell E. Moore of 88550 Oak Hill Cemetery Road, Eugene, Oregon 97402, phone 687-1431 for use of the waters of four wells.

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 12, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 100 gallons per minute, being 15 gpm from Well I (South A), 40 gpm from Well 2 (West), 40 gpm from Well 3 (Poplar), and 5 gpm from Well 5 (North)

, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users. measured at the point of diversion from the wells

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 1,787 feet North and 1,326 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 25, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4; Well 2 - 2,327 feet North and 1,640 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 25, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4; Well 3 - 2,756 feet North and 1,492 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 25, being within the SW 1/4 * A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* NE 1/4; Well 5 - 3,047 feet North and 1,483 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 25, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, all of Section 25, Township 17 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The use of ground water authorized herein shall not exceed 171/2 hours of diversion per week and shall be further restricted to use of water not to exceed 100 days per year.
