## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **C-10748** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Jack W. and Lucille L. Calvin** of 52655 Pengra-Huntington Road, LaPine, Oregon 97739, phone 536-1219 for use of the waters of one well

for the PURPOSE of **irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **June 17, 1982**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.054 cubic foot per second**

measured at the point of diversion from the **well**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **780 feet North and 1,112 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 35, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 10 East, WM, in the County of Deschutes.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 21 South, Range 10 East, WM:	Section 35	SE 1/4	NE 1/4	2.79 acres
		SW 1/4	NE 1/4	1.53 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **May 11, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1984**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1985**.
