### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-10768** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Dale E. Larrick of Route 1, Box 249, Bonanza, Oregon 97601, phone 545-6648** for use of the waters of one well

for the PURPOSE of **irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **July 2, 1982**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.78 cubic foot per second**

measured at the point of diversion from the **well**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **20 feet North and 20 feet East from the Southwest Corner of SE 1/4 NW 1/4, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 11 1/2 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South, Range 11 1/2 East, WM	Section 23	SW 1/4	NW 1/4	7.0 acres
		SE 1/4	NW 1/4	40.0 acres
		NE 1/4	SW 1/4	15.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that in the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **May 11, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1984**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1985**.
