PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10867 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert G. McKenzie, Jr., of PO Box 187, Port Orford, Oregon 97465, phone 332-3384 for use of the waters of three wells.

for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation, temperature control and flood harvest of cranberries, being 280 gallons per minute for each use provided the total diversion does not exceed 280 gpm

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 12, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 280 gpm, being 100 gpm from Well A, 80 gpm from Well B and 100 gpm from Well C

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well A - 262 feet South and 415 feet West from the 1/4 Corner between Sections 29 and 32, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 32; Well B - 2,125 feet South and 260 feet West, from the 1/4 Corner between Sections 29 and 32, being within SE 1/4 NW 1/4,*

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* Section 32; Well C - 600 feet North and 600 feet West, from the 1/4 Corner between Sections 29 and 32, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 29, all within Township 31 South, Range 15 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 11, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control on forms furnished.
