PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-10882** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Mountain Lakes Bible Camp, for United States, Winema National Forest, 2244 Wiard Street, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 883-2289** for use of the waters of a well

for the PURPOSE of **commercial use in a nonprofit church camp**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **February 18, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **20 gallons per minute**

measured at the point of diversion from the **well**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **960 feet North and 140 feet East from the S1/4 Corner of Section 21, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 21; Township 36 South, Range 6 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **May 11, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1984**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1985**.
