## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10900 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Renate Wolfsturm of PO Box 122, Silver Lake, Oregon 97638, phone 576-2334 for use of the waters from two wells.

for the PURPOSE of

irrication

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 22, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.47 cubic feet per second of water, being 0.47 cfs from Well 1 and 1.0 cfs from Well 2

measured at the point of diversion from the wells , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 310 feet North and 3940 feet East, from the SW Corner; Well 2 -1374 feet North and 1230 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 10, being within the 1 -SW 1/4 SE 1/4; 2 - NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 10, Township 28 South, Range 16 East, WM, in the County of Lake.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 28 South, Range 16 East, WM

Well I NW 1/4 NE 1/4 37.5 acres

Section 15

Well 2

Section 10

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 40.0 acres

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 40.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 13, 1984 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984 . Extended to Oct. 1985 Extended to October 1987

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985 Extended to October 1987
