PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10962 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to George Horning of Route 3, Box 588, Corvallis, Oregon 97330, phone 753-3004 for use of the waters from five wells, being 0.97 cubic foot per second of water from Well 1, 0.72 cfs from Well 4, 1.10 cfs from Well 5, 0.46 cfs from Well A, and 0.14 cfs from Well B for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 12, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 3.39 cubic feet per second

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 3040 feet North and 4550 feet East, being within SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 36; Well 4 - 2070 feet North and 4560 feet East being within NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 36; Well 5 - 3880 feet North and 5510 feet East being within SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 31; Well A - 1830 feet North and 3350 feet East being within NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 36; Well B - 320 feet *

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* North and 4660 feet East being within SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 36, all from the SW Corner of Section 36, Wells 1, 4, A, and B are all in Township 13 South, Range 5 West, WM, and Well 5 is in Township 13 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Benton.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 29, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
