### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-9638** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **City of Newberg of 414 East First Street, Newberg, Oregon 97132, phone 538-9421, for the use of the waters from Well 5,**

for the PURPOSE of **municipal water supply**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **March 28, 1980**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **1.01 cubic feet per second**

measured at the point of diversion from the **well**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **3470.96 feet North and 166.05 feet East from the East Northeast Corner of the J.F. Markley DLC, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 3 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Marion.**

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 25, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1985.
