PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10896 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Cell Tech, Inc. of PO Box 7326, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 882-5406 for use of the waters from a well,

for the PURPOSE of industrial use for washing algae off screens.

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 14, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 30.0 gallons of water per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the well , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 450 feet North and 90 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 25, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 39 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 39 South, Range 9 East, WM Section 25 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Industrial use

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 25, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 84.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 85.
