PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10815 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to JELD-WEN, inc. of 3303 Lakeport Boulevard, PO Box 1329, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 882-3451, for use of the waters from a well

for the PURPOSE of to assist in the reduction of algae growth in the channels of Harbor Islets subdivision

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 17, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1000 gallons per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the well , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: North 87 degrees, 42 minutes, 39 seconds, East 416.57 feet from the center quarter corner, being within the SW I/4 NE I/4 of Section 19, Township 38 South, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Provided that the permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department, all data pertaining to the use of water, including pumping times, quantity and temperature, provided further that the right established herein shall be subordinate and inferior to any future right for beneficial consumptive use from the same aquifer, provided further that if, in the opinion of the Water Resources Director, proof of beneficial use cannot be made under the terms of the permit, the permit will be canceled, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 20, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 85.
