PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-10910** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **The Apostolic Faith Mission of Portland, Oregon, 6615 Southeast 52nd Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97206, phone 777-1741, for use of the waters from a well**

for the PURPOSE of **heating and cooling and irrigation, being 200 gallons per minute for heating and cooling and 11.2 gpm for irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **March 29, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **211.2 gpm**

measured at the point of diversion from the **well**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **355 feet North and 995 feet East from the Southwest Corner of the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 18, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 18, Township 1 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Multnomah.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 South, Range 2 East, WM	Section 18	SW 1/4	SE 1/4	1.0 acre	irrigation, heating and air condi- tioning
	Section 19	NW 1/4	NE 1/4	1.0 acre	lawn watering and air condi- tioning

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided that use of water for air conditioning shall be subsequent in priority to future beneficial consumptive use unless the effluent is returned to the producing or other suitable ground water reservoir or is put to secondary beneficial consumptive use as directed or approved by the Water Resources Director.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **September 20, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1984**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1985**.
