PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10973 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Summit View Water System of PO Box 426, Oakridge, Oregon 97463, phone 782-2251, for use of the waters from one well

for the PURPOSE of

quasi-municipal

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

May 23, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second

measured at the point of diversion from the , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 2247 feet South, 0 degrees, 30 minutes, 6 seconds East and 1178 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 22, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 22, Township 21 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right granted herein shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 20, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 85.
