"CERTIFICATE NO. <u>67957</u> PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC W.

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11017 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Oregon Propogating Co., (an Oregon Corporation) of 15696 Highway 101 South, Brookings, Oregon 97415, phone 469-3136, for use of the waters from 14 wells, being 0.58 cubic foot per second from Wells 12, 13 and 14 when available, with any deficiency in the * irrigation and air temperature control

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 30, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.48 cubic foot per

measured at the point of diversion from the wells , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 12 - 1560 feet South and 775 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 15, within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 15; Well 13 - 1920 feet South and 505 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 15, within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 15; Well 14 - 1100 feet South and 850 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 15, within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of** A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- available supply from Wells 12, 13 and 14 to be made up by appropriation from Wells 1 through 11
- Section 15; all in Township 41 South, Range 13 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

Township 41 South, Range 13 West, WM Section 15 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 11.7 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre. and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 85 .
