PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10914 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to David Cheney of Cecil Star Route, Ione, Oregon 97843, phone 422-7252, for use of the waters from two wells, being 450 gallons of water per minute from Well 1 and 900 gpm from Well 2, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 4, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1350 gpm

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 2330 feet South and 231 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 8, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 8; Well 2 - 2442 feet South and 99 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 17, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 17, both being within Township 2 North, Range 23 *

Supplemental

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **November 17, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 . ~~Extended to Oct. 1, 1986~~ Extended to October 1987 Extended to October 1, 1988

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86 . Extended to October 1987
