PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10945 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to U.S. Army Corps of Engineers of Building 602, City-County Airport, Walla Walla, Washington 99362, phone (509)525-5500, for use of the waters from two horizontal water infiltration systems, being 20.07 cubic feet per second of water from Site 1 and 35.68 cfs from* rearing of fish from egg to release size

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 2, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 55.75 cubic feet per

measured at the point of diversion from the sites , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Infiltration System I - 900 feet North and 1250 feet East; Infiltration System 2 - 2000 feet North and 2900 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 15, being within the I - SW 1/4 SE 1/4; 2 - NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 5 North, Range 26 East, WM, in the County of Morrow.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* Site 2,

Township 5 North, Range 26 East, WM Section 15 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Fish hatchery rearing water

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 17, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
