PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION and the following limitations and conditions:

G-10970 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS

This permit is issued to Oregon State Parks and Recreation Division of 525 Trade Street, Salem, Oregon 97310, phone 378-5018, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of

potable water supply for general campground and park use

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

May 18, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

measured at the point of diversion from the , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 60 feet South and 60 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 26, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 22, 1984, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
