## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-10987** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Industrial Forestry Association of 225 Southwest Broadway, Room 400, Portland, Oregon 97205, phone 222-9505**, for use of the waters from Well 2 when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Well 2 to be made up by appropriation from Well 1 for the PURPOSE of **irrigation and temperature control, being 0.14 cubic foot per second of water for irrigation and 1.71 cfs for temperature control**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **June 9, 1983 for the use of 0.3 cfs for temperature control; August 19, 1983 for the use of 1.41 cfs for temperature control and for the use of 0.14 cfs for irrigation** and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **1.71 cubic feet per second**

measured at the point of diversion from the **wells**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **Well 1 - 1280 feet South and 580 feet West; Well 2 - 1040 feet South and 330 feet West, both from the Northeast Corner of Pendleton DLC 58, Section 28, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 South, Range 1 East, WM	Section 28	NW 1/4 SW 1/4	9.4 acres	irrigation and temperature control
	Section 29	NE 1/4 SE 1/4	2.0 acres	

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **November 22, 1984**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
