"CERTIFICATE NO. PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUB

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11010 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jack Westfall of 14887 Southeast 172nd Avenue, Clackamas, Oregon 97015, phone 658-5071, for use of the waters from a well,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 23, 1983 for 60.0 gallons of water per minute and August 18, 1983 for 24.0 gpm

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 84.0 gpm

, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users. measured at the point of diversion from the well

The well is to be LOCATED: 860 feet South and 1120 feet West from the N 1/4 Corner of Section 7, being within the NE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 7, Township 2 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 South, Range 3 East, WM

Section 7

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 12.75 acres

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.25 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 2, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
