## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11078 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Gary L. Wilks of 3522 Bellinger Lane, Medford, Oregon 97501, phone 773-7860, for use of the waters from a well,

for the PURPOSE of

irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

October 25, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second of water

measured at the point of diversion from the , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 820 feet North and 405 feet East from the Center Corner of Section 34, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 34, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South, Range 2 West, WM Section 34 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 3.8 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4 1.0 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. Use of water under this permit shall be limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that such appropriation does not interfere with or deplete the flow of Griffin Creek or any tributary thereof. Any depletion will require that the use of water from the sump to be shut down since Bear Creek and its tributaries have been closed to further appropriation.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 2, 1984 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
