PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10929 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Golden Rule Farms of PO Box 255, Christmas Valley, Oregon 97641, phone 576-2273, for use of the waters from three wells being 0.02 cubic foot per second from Well 1, 1.0 cfs from Well 3, and 1.6 cfs from unnamed well, for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 18, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.62 cfs

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 2640 feet South and 2600 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 27, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 27; Well 3 - 3750 feet South and 1290 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 27, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 27; Unnamed Well - 1325 feet South and 3965 feet West from the Northeast Corner of*
A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* Section 27, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 27 all being within Township 27 South, Range 17 East, WM, in the County of Lake.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 3, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
