PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11067 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Steven Goracke of Route 1, Box 664, Monroe, Oregon 97456, phone 847-5330, for use of the waters from two wells, being 1.68 cubic feet per second from Well 1 and 0.42 cfs from Well 2,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 29, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed cubic Der second

measured at the point of diversion from the wells , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 10 feet North and 990 feet East from the center of Section 23, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 23; Well 2 - 1770 feet North and 12 feet West, from the center of Section 23, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 23, both in Township 14 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Benton.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation

system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 24, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
