## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-11128** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Walter E. Klippstein of Route 5, Box 5229, Hermiston, Oregon 97838, phone 567-6532, for use of the waters from two wells, being 8.8 gallons per minute from Well 1 and 5.6 gpm from Well 2,**  
for the PURPOSE of **supplemental irrigation**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **October 5, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **14.4 gpm**

measured at the point of diversion from the **wells**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **Well 1 - 48 feet North and 1168 feet East; Well 2 - 170 feet North and 1173 feet East, both from the Southwest Corner of Section 6, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 North, Range 29 East, WM	Section 6	SW 1/4	NE 1/4	<u>Well 1</u>	1.58 acres
		SW 1/4	NE 1/4	<u>Well 2</u>	1.04 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 24, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
