PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11182 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

John N. Correa of Route I, Box 23, Echo, Oregon 97826, phone 376-8356, for This permit is issued to use of the waters from two sumps; being 1.34 cubic foot per second from each sump provided the total diverted shall not exceed 1.34 cfs,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

1.34 cubic feet per and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

measured at the point of diversion from the **sumps**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

Well I - 200 feet South and 870 feet West from the Northeast Corner of The well is to be LOCATED: Section 11, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 11; Well 2 - 800 feet South and 150 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 14, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, both within Township 3 North, Range 28 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 North, Range 28 East, WM

Section 10

NW 1/4 Primary Well 1 SE 1/4 36.0 acres

Supplemental Wells 1 and 2

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 35.7 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4 35.7 acres Section 15

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 10, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
