PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-11233** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Kinzua Corporation of Route 2, Box 2100, Heppner, Oregon 97836,** for use of the waters from two wells,

for the PURPOSE of **industrial uses, being 230 gallons per minute from Well 1 with back-up supply from Well 4 for uses in mill complex and 350 gpm from Well 4 with back-up supply from Well 1 for log deck sprinkling** that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **February 8, 1984 for use of 90 gpm from Well 1 and 350 gpm from Well 4, and February 17, 1984 for use of 140 gpm from Well 1**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **580 gpm**

measured at the point of diversion from the **wells**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **Well 1 - 1463 feet North and 3603 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 21, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21; Well 4 - 971 feet North and 2840 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 21, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 21, both within Township 2 South, Range 26 East, WM, ***
A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* in the County of Morrow.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **March 6, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
