PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10185 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to City of Klamath Falls of PO Box 237, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 883-5317, for use of the waters from production Well 2,

for the PURPOSE of primary source of geothermal fluids for heating

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 24, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 550 gallons per minute of water

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 670 feet North and 585 feet East from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 28, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 28, Township 38 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South, Range 9 East, WM Section 28 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Heating
Heat exchanger location

Provided that use of water for heating in excess of 5000 gallons per day shall be subsequent in priority to future beneficial consumptive use unless a two well system is constructed and all water wasted from the system recharged to the same ground water reservoir from which it was withdrawn.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 16, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
