### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10992 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Cloverdale Water District of PO Box 164, Cloverdale, Oregon 97112, phone 392-3279, for use of the waters from a shallow well,

for the PURPOSE of quasi-municipal

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 60 gallons per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the well, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 1060 feet South and 1000 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 26, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 4 South, Range 10 West, WM, in the County of Tillamook.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 30, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
