## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11254 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Rex Pierce of Route 1, Box 1820, Coquille, Oregon 97423, phone 347-3250, for use of the waters from a sump when available with any deficiency in the available supply from the sump to be made up by appropriation from a well, for the PURPOSE of irrigation, temperature control and flood harvesting of cranberries, being 0.11 cubic foot per second for irrigation, 0.675 cfs for temperature control and 0.23 cfs for flood harvesting that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 9, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.675 cubic foot per second

measured at the point of diversion from the

SUMP or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 1 - 2280 feet South and 580 feet West; 2 - 1960 feet South and 1140 feet West both from the Northeast Corner of Section 4, both being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM Section 4 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 4.5 acres

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 30, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985. Extended to Oct. 1, 1986 Extended to October 1987 Extended to October 1, 1988

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86. Extended to October 1, 1988
