### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10841 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Metropolitan Wastewater Management Commission (MWMC) of 225 North 5th Street, Suite 292, Springfield, Oregon 97477, phone 747-4551, for use of the waters from two wells, being 0.20 cubic foot per second from Well 1 and 2.23 cfs \* for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation from Well 2 and industrial use from Well 1

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 22, 1982 for 0.20 cfs and January 31, 1983 for 2.23 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.43 cfs

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 800 feet South and 600 feet East; Well 2 - 420 feet South and 740 feet East, both from the Northwest Corner of Section 34, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 34, Township 16 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 15, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 86.
