PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11243 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Pacific Power and Light Company, a Maine Corporation of 920 SW Sixth Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97204, phone 243-4088, for use of the waters from two wells, being 0.89 cubic foot per second from Well 4 and 1.34 cfs from Well 5, for the PURPOSE of quasi-municipal

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 8, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.23 cfs

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 4 - 795 feet South and 2271 feet East; Well 5 - 861 feet South and 2250 feet East both from the Northeast Corner of John E. Davidson DLC 44, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 28, Township 8 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 15, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1986.
