PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-11265** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Trans Energy-Oregon, Inc.**, of **11441 Willows Road, Redmond, Washington 98052-1012**, phone **(206)881-8500**, for use of the waters from **Well 1** with back-up supply from the auxiliary **Well 2**, for the PURPOSE of **industrial use**, to include boiler feed water, cooling tower make up water and water for sanitary purposes

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **April 19, 1984**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **500** gallons of water per minute

measured at the point of diversion from the **wells**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **Well 1 - 1666 feet North and 1297 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 17, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 17; Well 2 - 1592 feet North and 1512 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 17, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 17, both within Township 6 South, Range 2 West, WM, in***

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* **the County of Marion.**

Township 6 South, Range 2 West, WM Section 17 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Industrial use

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 13, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**. Extended to Oct. 1, 1986

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
