PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11186 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Delbert C. Pitcher of Route 3, Box 742, Junction City, Oregon, 97448, phone 998-6463, for use of the waters from two wells, being 0.85 cfs from Well 1 and 0.25 cfs from Well 2, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 88.5 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 21, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.10 cubic feet per second

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 577 feet South and 510 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 25, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 25; Well 2 - 1320 feet North and 600 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 25, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 25, both in Township 14 South, Range 5 West, WM, in *

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 7, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1987.
