PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11288 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Harold Akes of Route 4, Box 121, Milton-Freewater, Oregon 97862, phone 938-3849, for use of the waters from four wells,

for the PURPOSE of domestic water supply for 70 space mobile home park and two houses and irrigation of lawn and garden less than one-half acre for each space or homesite

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 6, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.15 cfs, being 0.07 cfs for domestic use and 0.05 cfs for irrigation of lawn and garden from Well "B" with backup supplies from Wells "A", "C" and "D" for use at mobile home park and "measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 120 feet South and 820 feet East from the Northwest Corner of $S^{W}/4$ Section 25, being within the NW 1/4 and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 25, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* 0.005 cfs each from Wells "A" and "C" for domestic use at two homesites and 0.01 cfs from Wells "A" and "C" for irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden at each.

Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM Section 25 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for water supply for mobile nome park

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 21, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
