PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11305 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to A.L. and R.O. Conforth of Box 38, Umatilla, Oregon 97822, phone 922-3476, for use of the waters from two wells,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 365.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 29, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.13 cubic foot per

measured at the point of diversion from the wells , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - North 45 degrees West 1717 feet from the Southeast Corner of Section 20; Well 2 - North 40.6 degrees West 1550 feet from the Southeast Corner of Section 20, both being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, Township 5 North, Range 29 East, WM, in the County of Umatilla.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

December 21, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable Actual construction work shall begin on or before diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
