## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-10991 and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Zabransky and Son, Route 1, Box 112, Stanfield, Oregon 97875, phone 449-3317, for use of the waters from five wells

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 47.9 acres and supplemental irrigation of 28.4 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 13, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.99 cubic feet per second; being 0.17 cfs from Well 1 when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Well 1 to be made up by appropriation from wells 2, 3, 4 and 5;\* measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 1220 feet North and 1940 feet West from the East 1/4, Corner of Section 24 being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 24; Well 2 - 750 feet South and 1180 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 25 being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 25; Well 3 - 160 feet North and 2660 feet East from\*\* A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- \* 0.17 cfs from Well 3 when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Well 3 to be made up by appropriation from Wells 2, 4 and 5; 0.39 cfs from Well 2 when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Well 2 to be made up by appropriation from Wells 1, 3, 4 and 5 and 0.26 cfs from Well 5 when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Well 5 to be made up by appropriation from Wells 1, 2, 3 and 4
- \*\* the Southwest Corner of Section 25 being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 24; Well 4 90 feet South and 1100 feet West from the East 1/4 Corner of Section 36 being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 36; Well 5 470 feet north and 70 feet West from the East 1/4 Corner of Section 25 being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 25, all wells are located in Township 4 North, Range 29 East, WM.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that in the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 30, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
