## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11311 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Stanford Nace of 4125 Azalea Glen Road, Glendale, Oregon 97442, phone 832-2552, for use of the waters from a pit well,

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m for\ the\ PURPOSE\ of}$  irrigation of 15.0 acres and commercial use (gravel processing and washing plant), being 0.19 cfs for irrigation and 1.67 cfs for commercial use

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 20, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.36 cubic foot of water per second

measured at the point of diversion from the well , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

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m The\ well\ is\ to\ be\ LOCATED:\ 800}$  feet North and 1000 feet East from the S 1/4 Corner of Section 20, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, Township 32 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 32 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 20 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 10.0 acres Irrigation SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Commercial use NW 1/4 SE 1/4 5.0 acres Irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This permit is issued subject to the maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning the water to the stream.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 27, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
