This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11342 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Hessel Bierma of 33142 S. Barlow Road, Woodburn, Oregon, 97071, phone 661-2422, for use of the waters from two wells,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 121.1 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 30, 1985 for 0.56 cubic foot per second and January 31, 1985 for 0.95 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.51 cfs from Well 1 when available with any deficiency in the available supply from Well 2 to be made up by appropriation from Well 2, measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1 - 570 feet South and 2420 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 19, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 19; Well 2 - 530 feet South and 670 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 19, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 19, both in Township 5 South Range 1 East, WM, in the * A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Provided further that in the event of a request for changes in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of these wells, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of these wells at the time of perfection of this right.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 8, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
