## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11333 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Multnomah County, Oregon of 2115 SE Morrison Street, Portland, Oregon, 97214, phone 248-5000, for use of the waters from one well (Well 1),

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 231.49 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 1, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.1 cubic foot per second

measured at the point of diversion from the well , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 90 feet North and 100 feet East from the Center Corner of Section 35, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35, Township 1 North, Range 2 East, WM, in the County of Multnomah.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 North, Range 2 East, WM Section 35 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 5.62 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4 39.2 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4 39.2 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4 31.7 acres Section 36 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 39.2 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 39.2 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4 39.2 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4 23.7 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4 13.67 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 28, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
