## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11347 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to The City of Sherwood by Tad Milburn, Director of Public Works of 90 NW Park, Sherwood, Oregon, 97140, phone 625-5522, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of municipal

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 13, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.5 cubic foot per second

measured at the point of diversion from the well , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: 1400 feet North and 50 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 32, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 32, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

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The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 2, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86. **Extended to October 1, 1992** 

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87. Extended to October 1, 1992
