PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-11359 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Greenwood Pacific Inc. of 1702 SW Goodwin Place, Pendleton, Oregon, 97801, phone 276-7225, for use of the waters from two wells,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation, being 0.05 cubic foot per second from Well 1 for irrigation of 2.0 acres, 0.06 cfs from Well 2 for the supplemental irrigation of 2.2 acres and 0.06 cfs from Well 2 for the supplemental * that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 14, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.17 cfs

measured at the point of diversion from the wells , or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 1-1540 feet North and 90 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 33, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 33; Well 2-800feet North and 920 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 34, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 34, both within Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM, ** A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- irrigation of 11.2 acres (to bring amount of water up to full duty)
- ** in the County of Umatilla.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

July 2, 1986 Actual construction work shall begin on or before , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87.
