### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION G-5209 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Hansell Brothers, Inc. by Stafford Hansell of Route 1, Box 173, Hermiston, Oregon, 97838, phone 567-5994, for use of the waters from seven wells,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 1589.2 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 9, 1970

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 19.88 cubic feet per second

measured at the point of diversion from the wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: Well 83, 88 - 1420 feet North and 490 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 27, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 27; Well 5 - 1130 feet North and 60 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 26, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26; Well 4 - 1160 feet North and 370 feet East \*

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- \* from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 26, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 26; Well 3 - 230 feet North and 1210 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 27, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 27; Well 3A - 2450 feet North and 460 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 27, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 27; Well 6 - 960 feet North and 1850 feet East from the W 1/4 Corner of Section 27, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 27; Well 649 - 1950 feet South and 1270 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 36, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 36, all within Township 3 North, Range 27 East, WM, in the County of Morrow.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to  $\frac{1}{80}$  of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be subject to the provisions of the Question of Determination of a Critical Ground Water Area in the Ordnance Area, Morrow and Umatilla Counties, Oregon by Special Order recorded at Volume 27, pages 40 through 79 dated the 2nd day of April, 1976.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 15, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 87 .
