PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-11127** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Irl M. Davis and Sharon Appleman of Route 1, Box 41 ID, Tygh Valley, Oregon, 97063, phone 544-2711, for use of the waters from one well,**

for the PURPOSE of **group domestic supplies for 75 families including irrigation of lawns and gardens not to exceed one-half acre per family**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **July 12, 1984**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.23 cubic foot per second**

measured at the point of diversion from the **well**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **1360 feet North and 740 feet East from the Center Corner of Section 9, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 4 South, Range 12 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 South, Range 12 East, WM Section 9	SW 1/4 NE 1/4	Domestic use for 35 families including lawns and gardens
	NW 1/4 SE 1/4	Domestic use for 40 families including lawns and gardens

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **July 29, 1986**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **86**.
Extended to October 1, 1992

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **87**.
Extended to October 1, 1992
